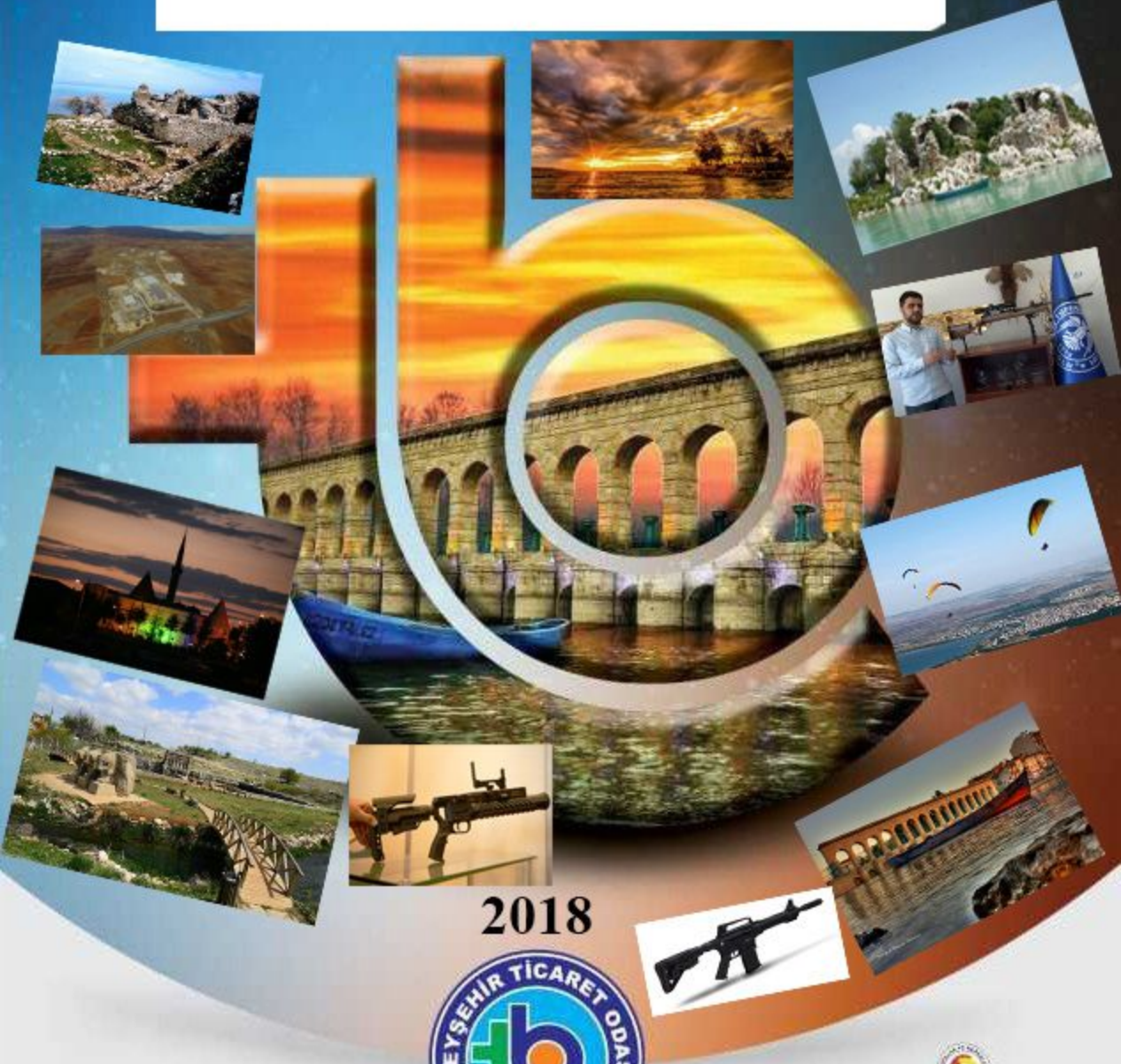

PREAMBLE

Beyşehir Chamber of Commerce is aiming to accelerate regional development and ensure the sustainability of regional development and reduce regional and regional development disparities. In order to achieve these objectives, it intends to develop cooperation between the public sector, private sector and non-governmental organizations, ensure the proper and effective use of resources and mobilize local potential.

Another tender was the tender for Beyşehir Chamber of Commerce (TR52) Region Technical Assistance and the activities to be carried out within this scope were aimed to ensure that the strategic plan and vision studies carried out by the Beyşehir Chamber of Commerce were comprehensive and in-depth.

SWOT analyzes were carried out by the contractor in district district meetings in districts in order to carry out the activities within the scope of the tender and the studies and plans conducted for the districts were examined. All studies were combined with a unique method based on the reinterpretation of competitiveness.

This document is the district report which forms the basis for the determination of vision strategies. It shows the current status of the district and forms the infrastructure for the use of district potentials.

In 2018, the data related to the district reports, which were prepared within the scope of the vision based on the vision of the region, were updated in 2018, mainly by the end of 2018 using TURKSTAT data.

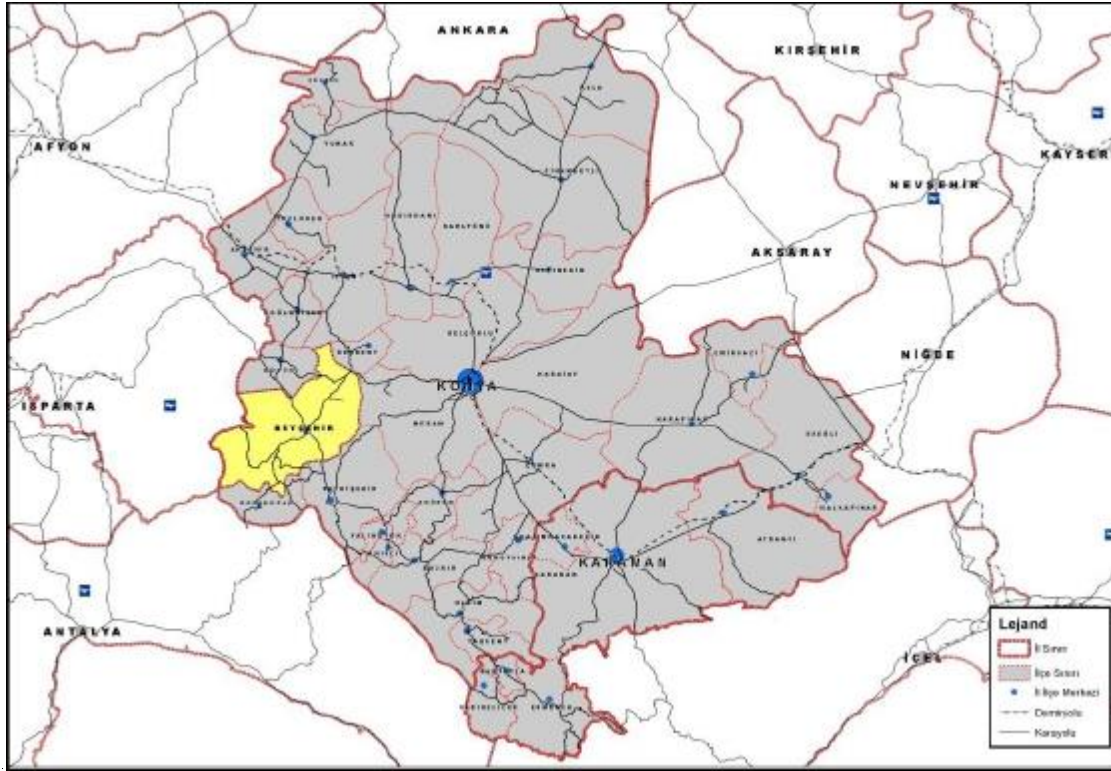

1. NATURAL STRUCTURE

1.1. GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES

BEYŞEHİR district of Konya is located between 37 ° 67 'North latitude and 31 ° 72' East longitude. Province 90 km from the center. The average height of the district above sea level is 1,125 meters. The district, East of Konya, north of Doganhisar, Huyuk and Ilgin, northeast of Derbent, northwest Şarkikaraağaç and Eğirdir districts of Isparta province, Yenişarbademli district of Isparta province, southwest of Isparta, Sutculer district, south Derebucak and southeast Seydisehir There. The area of the district is 2,121.7 km².



Located in the Lakes Region of the Mediterranean Region, BEYŞEHİR is also located at an important crossing point. BEYŞEHİR is located in the south and west of the Taurus Range Mountains, in the east of Erenler and in the north of Sultan Mountains. is a closed basin. BEYŞEHİR Lake is located in the middle of this basin in an area of 651 Km². Its highest point is the Dippoyraz hill, 2,890 meters high, on the Anamas Mountains. The most important river in the region is the main source of the Konya Plain Irrigation Project. River. In addition, Kızıloğlu Creek coming from forests, Hanboğazi Creek coming from Huğlu, Sogukpinar, Elze Creek, Ustunler Stream, Kavak Stream, Yesildag Dry Creek from around, Sarıöz Creek from Doğanbey and Sadıkhacı There are some small streams like Eflatunpinar Stream.

3.1.1. Crop Production

BEYŞEHİR district of 328.849% 55.04% of the cultivated land processed status wheat, 11.19% wheat (other), barley in 18,25%, sugar beet production is 4,84%. These products rye, oats, chickpeas, lentils, beans, industrial crops poppies, potatoes and sunflowers are grown. Depending on the climate and soil characteristics of the district, Almost all products are grown yield, the average yield of Konya and Turkey is quite high. In particular, wheat yields are among the most wheat yields in Turkey.

Kubad-Abad Palace

Kubad-abad Palace is located to the southwest of BEYSEHIR lake and Sultan Alaeddin Keykubat between the years 1226-1236. For permanent residence rather than a simple palace is a collection of Seljuk buildings. The tiles of Kubâd-Âbad Palace are in the glaze and luster technique It is made.

Eşrefoğlu Bedesteni

Bedesten: It is opposite the Eşrefoğlu Bath. In 1451 by the Ottomans as a covered market It was built.

Maiden's Tower

Harem Apartment by Alaaddin Keykubat on a rock in the lake opposite Kubadabat It was built as.
